NRI seat:

The management are entitled to fill up to 15% of total seats in NRI category by admitting qualified students who are dependence of NRI. According to GO (MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD DATED 06.08.2014, “an applicant who depends up on his/her father/mother/brothers/ sisters (inclusive of first cousin)/ husband/wife/brothers and sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of father or mother/half brother/half sister/adopt the father or adopted mother who is working abroad will only be eligible to apply in NRI category seat.

According to the Fees structure prescribed for the NRI category seat in ASC Order No. FRC50/25/NURSING/AMCSFNCK/PNCMAK dated 10.07.2025, the Annual Tuition Fees payable by students being admitted under the NRI category seats is Rs. 1,04,500/- per year. All other fees including special fees as detailed above of this prospectus are applicable to students admitted under the NRI category, too.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission (As per University norms).
- The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course), or Senior School Certificate Examination(10+2), Pre-Degree Examination (10+2), or an equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or university with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English with minimum of 50% aggregate marks (as per KUHS & INC norms). The due concessions in the minimum percentage of marks for SC/ST candidates are as per university rules.
- Candidate shall be medically fit.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

“Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil Court.”

How To apply

- A. A candidate who seeks admission to the MGM MMC College of Nursing, Ring Road, Pathanamthitta, under the management quota should submit an online application in the website of the college www.muthootnursingpta.com from 05.07.2026 to 05.08.2026
- B. Application fee of Rs. 1000/- to be remitted through payment gateway. Application submission will be completed only after successful payment of Application fee through online.
Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances.
- C. Along with the application form the following should be uploaded.
 - 1. Recent passport size photograph of candidate
 - 2. Signature of the candidate
 - 3. Copy of SSLC certificate
 - 4. Mark list of qualifying examination

Rank list will be published in the college website on 19.08.2026 (Please go through the admission schedule given at the end).

The Procedure of spot counselling, allotment and admission if required

- Spot counseling, allotment and admission in the merit rank order of applicants will be held to fill up the remaining vacant seats after three or four online allotments if required. The applicants shall register their options online on college website against available remaining vacancies for spot allotment. Those who receive allotment orders

as per their rank shall submit their original certificates, pay the fees and complete admission at the College counter on the spot.

All original documents and certificates should be submitted at the college desk at the time of spot admission

Out of 50% management seats 35% will be filled by managements from among the applications received by the MGM MMC College of Nursing, Ring Road Pathanamthitta on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria

Out of 50% management seats (15% of total seats) NRI seats shall be filled up from on the basis of merit list prepared based on the mark obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria. NRI category as per GO (MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, **“An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother /Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad” will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.**

Note: Relationship should clearly be established. In case relationship is mentioned as Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt only in the space provided for in the certificate, the Village Officer should give an explanation of the relation in the certificate itself. Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt should be explained with clear relationship. The relationship link should be clearly explained. Certificates showing mere Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt without establishing clear relationship link will be rejected. The Nursing College shall verify the documents properly before admitting the students.

SELECTION

The management and NRI rank lists of all applicants will be published separately on the website. The candidates will be selected only on the basis of merit on 19.08.2026, the website will be displaying the rank list, which will be compiled based on the scores received in the qualifying exam. Online notification will be used to announce the admission date.

Candidates should bring the following documents in original for verification.

NRI Category

The following original documents other than mentioned above shall be submitted at the time of admission.

1. **Declaration of the Sponsor** (The candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs. 200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and all the expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the sponsor)
2. **Relationship certificate issued by the village officer** (The certificate clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O(Ms)No. 243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.
3. **Valid passport copy of the sponsor with embassy Attestation.**

4. **Valid Visa copy of the sponsor with embassy Attestation.** (Arabic visa translated to English is mandatory)
5. **Employment Certificate of the Sponsor.** (The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped or the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or Consulate)

THE CUT-OFF DATE OF ADMISSION

The cut-off date of admission to Nursing Course will be as per the notification issued by the KUHS and Government of Kerala.
